PM to depart for two-day KSA visit today



ISLAMABAD: Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif would depart for a two-day visit to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) on Monday. The PM would participate in the Saudi Investment Summit (SIS) and meet with Saudi Crown Prince Muhammad Bin Salman and King Salman bin Abdul Aziz.

The PM is embarking on the tour on Crown Prince Muhammad Bin Salman's invitation.

According to media reports, the Crown Prine MBS is also expected to visit Pakistan next month. Pakistan, in the wake of statements made against the Kingdom in the context of the Organization of Oil Exporting Countries (OPEC+) decision, expressed solidarity with the leadership of Saudi Arabia.

"We appreciate the concerns of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for avoiding market volatility and ensuring global economic stability," the Foreign Office said in a statement.

The statement added, Pakistan encourage constructive approach on such issues based on engagement and mutual respect."

Detailed verdict of Toshakhana case likely today

PTI's Fawad Chaudhry questions delay in issuance of detailed verdict

ISLAMABAD: After issuing its short order disqualifying PTI Chairman Imran Khan in the Toshakhana case on October 31, the Election Commission of Pakistan will likely issue its detailed decision today (Monday).

According to media reports, the electoral body issued its verdict against Khan on the basis of Article 63(1)(p) for making "false statements and incorrect declaration" regarding the Toshakhana gifts.

Headed by the Chief Election Commissioner Sikandar Sultan Raja, the ECP's five-member bench unanimously ruled against the former prime minister. The commission, in its judgement, stated that the PTI chief is no more a member of the National Assembly and deemed his response "not correct".

Earlier on Sunday, PTI leader Chaudhry Fawad Hussain questioned the detailed verdict's in the case, inquiring what the CEC read on Friday if there was no verdict to release even after 24 hours.

Chaudhry maintained that if the verdict did not carry the signatures of all the ECP members, then it was not a judgment.

The ECP's initial verdict reads as follows: As a sequel to our abovementioned findings, facts available on record and keeping in view the argument of learned counsel for parties herein, we are of the considered opinion that the Respondent has become disqualified under Article 63(1)(p) of Constitution read with Section 137,167 and 173 of the Elections Act, 2017, consequently he ceases to be a member of the National Assembly of Pakistan and his seat has become vacant accordingly.

ISLAMABAD: Istanbul Declaration adopted by the 12th Session of the Islamic Conference of Information Ministers has emphasized upon the importance of cooperation among the member states in developing necessary mechanisms to fight disinformation and other related challenges of the Post-Truth era.

The declaration also underlined the need for devising short, medium and long-term strategic processes in the total fight against disinformation.

The Information Ministers of the OIC Member States, participated in the Islamic Conference of Information Ministers, titled 'Combating Disinformation and Islamophobia in the Post-Truth Era' held in Turkiye on October 22.

The declaration said that the conference recognized the importance of focusing on specific issues and possible scenarios in the short term, multidimensional crisis communication and management and mechanisms to check the accuracy of the information in the medium term, and news content, media literacy and digital media literacy in the long term.

The conference took into consideration the Final Report of the 12th



Islamic Conference of Information non and highlighting the risks it posed Ministers, which aimed to promote OIC Member States' contributions and cooperation in the area of media and information, a press release of the OIC Secretariat said.

The Istanbul Declaration underscored the need to combat Islamophobia/hatred against Islam in all its manifestations by presenting the truth about the magnanimous religion of Islam in an effective manner, utilizing new and emerging platforms and technological innovations.

Underscoring the perils of disinformation as a destructive weapon, the declaration said, it was easy to wield and require complex measures to counter, targeting the noble religion of Islam and the need to combat this phenome-

particularly in countries with Muslim communities and minorities.

It recognized the necessity of raising awareness against disinformation and fake news through social norms.

The declaration highlighted the importance of combatting disinformation, which posed a serious threat to their countries and societies in the new digital era, as encapsulated in the theme chosen for the conference.

"Recognizing that terrorism has no particular identity and that correlating this term with other identities is a product of disinformation and condemning all manifestations of violence, extremism, fanaticism and terrorism which distort the noble messages of human cultures," the declaration said.

LAHORE: Former chief minister of Punjab and PML-N leader Hamza Shahbaz has been appointed as the leader of the Opposition in the provincial assembly, according to a notification issued on Sunday.

Hamza became the chief minister of Punjab on April 30, 2022, after which he was de-notified as the Opposition leader. However, the PML-N-led government lost its power in Punjab

after Pervez Elahi became the chief minister of the province as the Supreme Court had declared the ruling of former Punjab Assembly deputy speaker Dost Muhammad Mazari in the chief minister's election "illegal".

Elahi, who had been defeated by Hamza on July 22 during the Punjab CM's election after 10 PML-Q votes were rejected by former deputy speaker Mazari – had challenged the ruling in the SC.

The Supreme Court, in an 11-page

short order, had said: "We find that the understanding and implementation of the said short judgment as well as the provisions of Article 63A(1)(b) of the Constitution by the Deputy Speaker, Provincial Assembly of Punjab, Lahore (Respondent No.1) was patently incorrect and erroneous and cannot be sustained.

The order then declared Elahi as the duly elected chief minister of Punjab as it ruled that he had obtained 186 votes compared to Hamza's 179.



Early HIV diagnosis, treatment important for long-term health

ISLAMABAD: Starting antiretroviral treatment (ART) early in the course of HIV infection when the immune system is stronger results in better long-term health outcomes compared with delaying ART, according to findings presented today at the IDWeek Conference in Washington, D.C.

The findings are based on an extended follow-up of participants in the National Institutes of Health-funded Strategic Timing of Antiretroviral Treatment (START) study. In 2015, START demonstrated a 57% reduced risk of AIDS and serious non-AIDS health outcomes among participants who began ART when their CD4+ T-cell counts - a key indicator of immune system health - were greater than 500 cells per cubic millimeter (mm*) compared with those who did not begin ART until either their CD4+ counts fell below 350 cells/mm* or they developed AIDS. Following the 2015 report of these findings, the participants in the deferred treatment arm were advised to begin ART.

Approximately, 1.2 million people in the United States are living with HIV, and roughly 13% do not know they are infected, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. When HIV diagnosis and treatment are delayed, HIV continues to replicate. This can negatively



impact the infected individual's health and increase the risk of transmitting the virus to others.

The international START study proved the benefit of early ART initiation, but longer-term follow-up of 4,446 participants was undertaken to determine whether the health benefits of early ART compared with deferred ART increased, remained constant, or declined after the participants in the deferred arm were advised to begin ART. The primary study endpoints included the number of participants who developed AIDS; those who developed serious non-AIDS health conditions, such as major cardiovascular disease, kidney failure, liver disease and cancer; and those who died.

For participants who began ART before the end of 2015, the median CD4+ cell count at the time of ART initiation was 648 cells/mm* for the immediate arm and 460 cells/mm* for the deferred arm. The analysis presented today compared the primary study endpoints before the end of 2015, with those in the extended follow-up period, from Jan. 1, 2016, to Dec. 31, 2021. In the latter period, most deferred-arm participants were taking ART. During the second period, people initiating ART in the deferred group had rapid and sustained declines in HIV viral load (less than or equal to 200 copies/mL); however, CD4+ cell counts remained, on average, 155 cells lower compared with that of individuals in the immediate ART group. While the risk of serious health outcomes was substantially diminished soon after ART was initiated in the deferred treatment group, some excess risk remained compared with the immediate treatment group. The deferred ART group continued to have a somewhat greater risk (21%) of serious health consequences or death in comparison to the immediate treatment group. Twenty-seven cases of AIDS occurred in the five-year follow-up period in the deferred treatment group compared with 15 cases in the early treatment group. Similarly, 88 cases of serious non-AIDS health issues occurred in the deferred treatment arm compared with 76 cases in the immediate treatment arm. Lastly, there were 57 deaths in the deferred treatment group compared to 47 in the immediate treatment arm.

Removal from FATF's grey list an achievement

he Financial Action Task Force has announced to formally remove Pakistan from its grey list. This was announced by FATF President T Raja Kumar in Paris on Friday. T Raja Kumar said Pakistan had been on the grey list since 2018 and after a lot of work by the Pakistani authorities, they completed a combined 34 action items to address deficiencies in the anti-money laundering and counterterrorism financing systems. Raja Kumar said FATF welcomes this significant progress as a result Pakistan can now more effectively tackle anti-money laundering and terror financing. He said an FATF team has verified that the reforms are in place and that there is a high-level of commitment and capacity to sustain those reforms. Raja Kumar said these reforms are good for the stability of the country and the region.

Inclusion into grey list of FATF had been one of the major sources of strain on Pakistan's economy which created a lot of challenges for the country. Due to this nuisance created by our enemy, it cost us decline in foreign direct investment, dwindling foreign exchange reserves and a nerve raking experience for businesses in Pakistan. The banking sector also faced a stress as it had to operate under a lot of restrictions. Finally, due to our diplomatic lobbying efforts and various measures required to fulfill the FATF conditions, we are successfully out of this list. It will have an impact on flight of dollars from Pakistan and the price of rupee will appreciate vs. dollar. It will also open the door to foreign investments into the country. It will also help bringing stability in the system with improvement in financial well-being of the country.

It is very good news that Pakistan has come out of FATF's grey list. We suffered for a long time under the list. Our banks will now be able to open the LCs without any issue, and foreign direct investment will pour into the country in various sectors. All the stakeholders played their full role in getting the country out of this penalty. Now, we need to be watchful in future in the areas of terror financing, money laundering and financial transactions. We have to ensure proper documentation of financial transactions of individuals as well as institutions.

Getting out of the grey list is a remarkable achievement of Pakistan. Pak Army, ANF, banking sector and all other institutions of Pakistan really worked hard to get the country out of the grey list of Financial Action Task Force. With quest for global socio-economic development, Chinese President Xi Jinping introduced the BRI. It is assessed that this Chinese initiative will develop its economy with infrastructure development at the rate of 6000 km per year



was a series of popular pro-democracy uprisings that enveloped several largely Muslim countries. The events began in the spring of 2011. However, the political and social impact of these popular uprisings remains significant today.

The term "Spring" refers to the Revolutions of 1848 also known as the "People's spring" when political upheavals swept Europe. Ever since spring has been used to describe movements toward democracy. Western media began popularizing the term "Arab Spring". After successful uprisings in Tunisia and Egypt presidents, it also gave hope to Syrian pro-democracy activists.

The movement starts in March 2011 when a peaceful protest erupted in Syria after 15 boys were detained and tortured for writing graffiti in support of the Arab Spring. One of the boys, a 13-year-old, was killed after having been brutally tortured. The Syrian government, led by President Bashar al-Assad, responded to the protests by killing hundreds of demonstrators and imprisoning many more. The event caused the situation to develop into a full-blown civil war.



Two pilots killed as Russian fighter jet crashes It is the second such fatal incident in six days involving a Sukhoi fighter plane

IRKUTSK: A Russian military jet crashed into a residential building in the Siberian city of Irkutsk on Sunday and the two pilots were killed, officials said, the second such fatal incident in six days involving a Sukhoi fighter plane.

In a post on Telegram, Irkutsk governor Igor Kobzev said the plane crashed into a two-storey house in the city. He published a video showing firefighters clambering over the wreckage and directing jets of water at the still smouldering rubble.

No one on the ground was hurt, the governor said.

Officials said the plane was a Sukhoi Su-30 fighter on a test flight. Last Monday, a Sukhoi Su-34 crashed into an apartment block in the southern city of Yeysk, near Ukraine, and at least 15 people were killed. Authorities said an initial investigation of that disaster-in which

the pilots ejected-pointed to a technical malfunction of the aircraft.

Videos of Sunday's incident, shared on social media, showed the plane dived almost vertically before crashing in a fireball, sending dense black smoke into the sky. Kobzev said 150 nearby homes were without electricity and work was underway to restore power. Reuters

Five killed in militant attack on hotel in Somalia



MOSCOW: An ongoing siege of a hotel in the Somalian port city of Kismayo by Islamist militants has left five people killed, Somalian news website Garowe Online reported on Sunday.

In an earlier report, the news website said that eight people were injured in the attack, including children from a school located nearby.

Militants started the siege of Tawakal Hotel, a popular meeting place for government officials, by detonating a car bomb, according to reports.

Al-Shabaab, an Islamist group affiliated with al-Qaeda (terrorist organization, banned in Russia), has claimed the responsibility for the blast. The radical group has been waging armed insurgency against the government of Somalia for years and is controlling large areas in the southern and central parts of the country. Sputnik

With the war about to start its ninth month and winter approaching, the potential for freezing misery loomed as Russia continued to attack Ukraine's power grid.

Since Oct. 10, Russia has launched devastating salvos at Ukraine's power infrastructure, hitting at least half its thermal power generation and up to 40% of the entire system.

Officials in a swath of regions on Saturday reported strikes on energy facilities and power outages as engineers scrambled to restore the network. Governors advised residents to stock up on water.

More than a million people were without power, said presidential adviser Kyrylo Tymoshenko. Parts of Kyiv suffered power cuts into the evening, and a city official warned strikes could leave Ukraine's capital without power and heat for "several days or weeks".

Muslim schoolchildren in France often denied halal food options Court ruling found offering alternate menu choices did not violate secularist principles

PARIS: Although the subject gets little media coverage, the problem of food in French school cafeterias is a headache for many parents of Muslim students.

Citing their version of secularism, some mayors have decided not to offer alternative menus in school cafeterias.

This is the case in Tassin-la-Demi-Lune, a commune on the outskirts of Lyon, which since 2016 has mandated that only a single menu be offered for school meals

offered is sometimes centered around pork, students who eat only halal or kosher - approved under Muslim or Jewish guide-

lines, respectively - have trouble getting enough to eat.

To get around this problem, some mayors have proposed an exclusively vegetarian menu,

citing environmental concerns These mayors have given the choice to parents with three possible menus: meat, fish, or vegetarian. The Grenoble City Hall asked parents to choose the menu they wanted, and 94% opted for fish or beef/chicken menus.

Children in those schools were able to choose their meals, unlike And when the only meal the situation created by other mayors who think that secularism means making Muslim and Jewish children either eat pork or go hungry.

Faced with a lack of empathy by mayors, parents in schools where pork is often the only choice launched an online petition to demand alternative menus.

They said that last December, the Council of State clearly ruled that proposals for alternative menus in fact do no undermine ecularism or religious neutrality. Moreover, it argued that "a

single menu goes against the sense of history at a time when food waste is being criticized."

'The unique menu, defended by the City Council in Tassinla-Demi-Lune, hinders access to catering for 20% of students, whether for religious reasons, health, or belief (vegetarianism),"

said the parents' petition, adding: "The role of a mayor is to serve the population, all the population, in the name of the general welfare."

Several well-known figures, including journalist and feminist activist Rokhaya Diallo, have lent support to the petition and encouraged others to sign it.

In France, Muslims are subjected to unrelenting attacks and exclusion amid an intensifying debate over the visibility of the community.

There is a question about the definition and concrete application of the principle of secularism. While some want to go further by prohibiting any "Muslim-related" visibility, others are looking to live

"My second final this year means a lot, especially kind of the last tournament of the year to finish really strong, win or lose tomorrow, is just kind of the icing on the cake of two really good years. I'm really proud of myself."

Pegula's path to the final has included victories over four Grand Slam winners: a second round win over Wimbledon champion Elena Rybakina followed US Open champions Bianca Andreescu and Sloan Stephens and Azarenka.

But the world number five said there were still some nerves heading into the title clash. "At the same time you're happy to be there," Pegula said.
