SP Adeel Akbar of Islamabad Police 'commits suicide'

ISLAMABAD: Islamabad's Superintendent of Police (SP) Adeel Akbar reportedly committed suicide by shooting himself in the federal capital on Thursday.

The incident took place near a private hotel in I-9 sector, where the police officer allegedly used a firearm to end his life.

According to police sources, SP Adeel Akbar sustained severe wounds after allegedly shooting himself and was immediately shifted to PIMS Hospital for treatment. Despite doctors' efforts, he succumbed to his wounds shortly after arrival.

Initial information suggests the officer took the weapon from his official security guard before the incident. The exact sequence of events and motive for the incident remain unclear as investigators gather details from



witnesses and forensic teams examine the evidence.

Police teams have cordoned off the area around the hotel while evidence collection continues. Statements from staff and nearby security personnel are also being recorded to determine the circumstances leading to the

The incident has sent shockwaves through the Islamabad Police Department, where SP Adeel Akbar was known as a senior and experienced officer. Senior police officials arrived at the location shortly after receiving reports and supervised the ongoing investigation.

Authorities have yet to release an official statement about the reasons behind the officer's apparent suicide. His body has been moved for post-mortem examination as part of standard procedure.

Investigators are reviewing CCTV footage from the vicinity and have seized the weapon used in the incident. Forensic experts are also examining ballistic evidence to confirm the sequence of events.

Police officials have not yet confirmed whether any disciplinary or personal issues may have contributed to the act. Sources indicate that a comprehensive inquiry is underway to determine the circumstances surrounding the officer's final moments.

Experts Highlight Economic and Health Toll of Iodine Deficiency at BZU Seminar

MULTAN: On the eve of World Iodine Deficiency Day, the Department of Food Science & Technology, in collaboration with Nutrition International and the Department of Human Nutrition, organized a seminar emphasizing the importance of iodine in human health. Experts from academia, developmental partners, and the Punjab Food Authority underscored that iodine deficiency continues to impose significant health and economic burdens on Pakistan.

In his presidential address, Prof. Dr. Saeed Akhtar, Former and Founding Dean of the Faculty of Food Science, revealed that iodine deficiency contributes to direct and indirect financial losses estimated at Rs704 billion annually, largely due to reproductive and cognitive impairments, disabilities, and thyroid-related disorders.

Mr. Ehtesham Ul Haq Tariq, Provincial Manager at Nutrition International, elaborated on the salt iodization process and reported that Punjab has achieved over 79% coverage of iodized salt, owing to collaborative efforts between institutions, regulators, and communities.

Event organizers Dr. Tariq Ismail and Prof. Dr. Tauseef Sultan commended Nutrition International's initiatives to reduce micronutrient deficiencies through its large-scale food fortification programs and lauded its continued support for nationwide coverage.

Trump's Gaza Gamble Backfires on Both Israel and Iran

another devastating assault on the Gaza Strip, killing more than 40 civilians and wounding dozens. The attack, which Israeli officials claim was a response to the killing of two of its soldiers by Hamas, has reignited international outrage and raised urgent questions about the fate of President Donald Trump's 21-point Middle East peace plan. Many observers believe that this assault, like the wars before it, was less a response to provocation and more an attempt to derail the peace framework that could constrain Israel's territorial ambitions.

In an urgent diplomatic push, President Trump dispatched Vice President J. D. Vance to Israel to secure the government's commitment to at least the first stage of the plan. At a joint press conference with Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, the contrast between Washington's tone and Jerusalem's defiance was striking. Throughout the entire event, Netanyahu avoided any reference to the peace plan or to Israel's obligations under it. Vice President Vance, on the other hand, stressed that the plan would allow international agencies to feed the starving population of Gaza, rebuild shattered infrastructure, and ensure security guarantees for both Israelis and Pales-

Consequently, the plan represents a terrible blow to Israel, one it may neither easily digest nor forgive. In the coming days, Israel is likely to take every possible measure to sabotage this peace process and return to its earlier trajectoryresuming the killing, reoccupying Gaza and the West Bank, expanding illegal settlements, and advancing toward its long-cherished dream of a "Greater

Analysts note that this political and psychological blow explains Netanyahu's open hostility to the plan. His far-right cabinet views Trump's initiative as an existential threat to their vision of a regional Israel dominating the Middle East under the banner of divine entitlement. For them, the peace plan undermines

decades of ideological investment and military strategy, forcing Israel to confront a future where Palestinian sovereignty is not just tolerated but internationally guaran-

Ironically, Hamasthe very organization long branded as the obstacle to peace-

appears more willing than Israel to accept the plan's early conditions. For Hamas, exhausted by siege and isolation, participation offers a chance to regain legitimacy and to attract Arab reconstruction funds. Arab monarchies, too, now see in this plan an opportunity to curtail Iran's influence in the region by weakening Hamas, Hezbollah, and other Tehranaligned groups. Their alignment with Washington and Trump's diplomacy has become a tool to re-engineer Middle Eastern politics around a new Sunni-led

Yet the geopolitical centerpiece remains Iran. Tehran, though not a signatory to the plan, looms over every conversation. It alone among Muslim powers retains both the will and the capability to confront Israel militarily. Were it not for U.S. intervention, Israel could have faced a deeper crisis during the recent regional escalation, when Iran demonstrated unprec-

edented drone and missile capabilities. For this reason, the peace plan's architects understand that no durable arrangement is possible without Iran's eventual inclusion or at least tacit restraint.

Still, Israel and Iran now stand on opposite sides of Trump's initiative—each rejecting it for different reasons. Israel sees it as a brake on its territorial expan-

sion; Iran views it as an American-Israeli tool to marginalize its regional role. Meanwhile, the so-called "middle bloc" of Muslim nations-Turkey, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, Pakistan, and several Gulf statessupport the plan conditionally. They will fund

Gaza's reconstruction only after Hamas is dismantled and new governance structures are in place.

This triangulation has created an uneasy balance: two powerful opponents of the plan, Israel and Iran, confronting a coalition of pragmatic states determined to stabilize the region under U.S. oversight. European nations, pressured by outraged publics and student protests, have also pivoted toward endorsing Palestinian statehood and humanitarian aid. They now see peace in Gaza not as a moral luxury but as a political necessity to preserve their own credibility.

If Israel continues to resist implementation, it risks isolation not only diplomatically but also domestically. American universities, churches, and media outlets are increasingly critical of Israel's conduct. The moral authority Israel once claimed as a besieged democracy is collapsing under the weight of documented atrocities and live-streamed

destruction. Without Trump's backing, its expansionist agenda could face unprecedented limits.


In this new geopolitical equation, the probable losers are Israel, Iran, and Hamas—each for different reasons Israel loses because it is constrained; Iran loses because its influence may shrink; Hamas loses because it is being rendered irrelevant. The relative winners are the Sunni Arab states, Turkey, Pakistan, and European nations, whose commitment to reconstruction and stability aligns with public opinion and global expectations.

Yet the success of this ambitious plan depends on unprecedented diplomatic coordination. It demands financial commitment from the Arab world, political discipline from Israel, and restraint from Iran. It also requires sustained U. S. engagement—an uncertain prospect in an election year when domestic divisions are deep and foreign entanglements unpopular.

If these elements can somehow be harmonized, Trump's peace plan could usher in the first tangible path toward Palestinian sovereignty in decades. If they fail, the region will once again descend into chaos-driven by the same forces of mistrust and ambition that have defined the Middle East for generations.

For now, the world watches anxiously. hoping that sanity prevails, that Israel resists the temptation of renewed aggression, and that the people of Gaza may finally reclaim the right to live with dignity, freedom, and peace.

Subject: India's Belligerent Military Occupation of Jammu and Kashmir: A Persistent Threat to Peace and Stability in South

Excellency,

Kashmiris on both sides of the Line of Control are set to observe the 79th Black Day on October 27, 2025, marking seventy-nine years of the illegal and forcible occupation of their motherland by India—a state that continues to cling to a position devoid of legal, moral, or constitutional legitimacy over a territory that has never been an integral part of the Indian Union.

Under international law, Jammu and Kashmir does not belong to any member state of the United Nations. It is recognized by the United Nations as a disputed territory whose final status remains to be determined in accordance with the will of its people.

Under the BJP-led regime, India continues to employ colonial-era tactics to subjugate the Kashmiri people and suppress their legitimate political aspirations. The long-standing dispute has claimed nearly one hundred thousand lives over the past 36 years. This unending cycle of violence, bloodshed, and abuse of power by the Indian state has resulted in grave human rights violations and widespread destruction.

Through its coercive state apparatus, the Indian government has sought to crush every form of dissent. Thousands of political activists, journalists, and civil society members have been arbitrarily

detained under draconian laws such as the UAPA and PSA. Fundamental freedoms—including the rights to speech, expression, protest, and peaceful assembly—remain severely curtailed. Arbitrary arrests, detentions, torture, and harassment have become routine tools to silence the local press, human rights defenders, and civil society voices who expose the suffering of Kashmiris and ongoing violations in the region.

Tragically, the Indian government continues to employ deceit and deception to mislead the international community and conceal the crimes committed by its forces in occupied Jammu and Kashmir.

It is a well-established historical fact that the dispute over Jammu and Kashmir can only be resolved in accordance with the will of its people, ascertained through a free and impartial plebiscite under international supervision. This principle was mutually agreed upon by both India and Pakistan and received unanimous endorsement from the United Nations Security Council, with strong support from the United States, the United Kingdom, and France. These resolutions were not routine declarations; they were the product of detailed UN-mediated negotiations and were endorsed only after both governments gave explicit consent. They therefore constitute a binding international commitment toward a peaceful settlement of the dispute.

India's continued refusal to implement the UN-endorsed roadmap and to uphold the Kashmiris' right to self-determination has allowed this long-standing dispute to fester, turning it into a source of deep regional instability and a potential flashpoint with far-reaching consequences. The recent Indo-Pak confrontation in May this year, which brought the two nuclear-armed states to the brink of a catastrophic war, further underscores the grave dangers posed by the unresolved Kashmir issue.

The United Nations, as the custodian of international peace, justice, and self-determination, bears both the moral responsibility and the institutional mandate to facilitate a just and lasting resolution of the Jammu and Kashmir dispute. Reviving the spirit of the original UN framework-anchored in the principles of international law, equity, and the right to self-determination—is imperative.

Lasting peace and stability in Jammu and Kashmir, and by extension in South Asia, can only be achieved through sincere dialogue, deeper international engagement, and inclusive political processes. The cost of continued inaction is too serious to ignore—not only for the region but for global peace and

It is high time that the United Nations ssumes its long-overdue role in holding India accountable for the crimes perpetrated by its forces in the occupied territory and in helping to resolve the dispute in accordance with the wishes and aspirations of the Kashmiri people.




